**ORDER CONCERNING VANSANT COMPROMISE**

At Fort Wayne, Indiana, on July 6, 2004

Currently pending before the court in this case is the Trustee's motion to compromise claims being asserted by Sherill and Bobbi Vansant together with Enodis Corporation's objection thereto, as well as the Trustee's motion to strike that objection.. Pursuant to the court's order of March 25, 2004, proceedings concerning the motion and objection were deferred pending a decision from the United States District Court for the Northern District of Indiana in Enodis Corporation v. Freeland, case no. 4:04-CV-10AS, because that case appeared to involve a potentially dispositive issue concerning the Trustee's's motion to strike. The District Court issued its decision on May 3, 2004. As a result it is appropriate to resume proceedings concerning the Trustee's motion to compromise and Enodis Corporation's objection thereto. IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Enodis Corporation shall file any brief in opposition to the Trustee's motion to strike within fourteen (14) days of this date and the Trustee shall file any reply thereto within seven (7) days thereafter. Upon the submission of all briefs or the expiration of the briefing schedule, the issues raised by the Trustee's motion to strike Enodis Corporation's objection to the Trustee's motion to compromise the Vansant controversy will be taken under advisement. Further proceedings, if any, will be scheduled by separate order following the court's decision as to the motion to strike.
