Trustee Daniel Freeland, having filed a motion for authority to compromise and settle litigation entitled Sherill and Bobby Vansant, et al., vs. Consolidated Industries Corporation, et al Case No. CV 99-221 currently pending in the Circuit Court of Shelby County, Alabama, for the allowance of a pre-petition general unsecured claim in the amount of Two Thousand Dollars (\$2,000.00) in favor of the Vansant plaintiffs, which claim may not be transferred, assigned or sold to any party without the express written consent of the Trustee, which consent may be unreasonably withheld, and to allow Consolidated's insurers to pay certain insurance policy proceeds, and no objections having been filed, the Trustee's motion is granted.
